AMENDMENT #5 to the SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. SAILING INSTRUCTION 16 – PENALTY SYSTEM

DELETE SI 16.1 and replace with the following:

16.1 A yacht that may have broken a rule of Part 2 while racing may take a penalty at the time of the incident as follows:

- (a) for Farr 40 and Farr 395 Classes, in accordance with RRS 44.1 and 44.2 as changed by SI 1.8
- (b) for all other classes, taking a:
 - (i) Two-Turns Penalty in accordance with rule 44.2, or
 - (ii) Scoring Penalty in accordance with rule 44.3.

This changes rule 44.1.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS 4.3 and 4.5 and BENETEAU FIRST 36.7 CLASS FLAG

SI 4.3 is changed to read: “Each yacht shall display the numeral pennant or class flag corresponding to her class designation from her backstay...”

SI 4.5 is changed by replacing “class numeral pennant” with “class flag.”

The Beneteau First 36.7 class flag is the Beneteau flag distributed at registration.

3. SAILING INSTRUCTION 8

ADD SI 8.8 – There will be a windward offset mark adjacent to the windward mark for all courses. This changes the diagram for courses “O” and “K” in Appendix 1 – Course Card 2006.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTION 18.7

In SI 18.7, delete the reference to sailing instruction 11.4 and replace with 11.7.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTION 18.8

In SI 18.8, delete the words “and may result in the yacht being scored DNE (Disqualification not excludable)”
