### **AMENDMENT #1 to the SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

**1. Delete SI 5.2 and replace with:**

5.2 The scheduled time for the course signals for the first class to start is 1055 and the first warning signal is 1100 for the first race each day. For subsequent races, the course signals will be made at or before the warning signal.

**2. Delete SI 10.3 and replace with:**

10.3 The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the Race Committee Signal Boat and the course side of the port-end starting mark OR the orange flag on the port-end Race Committee Pin Boat if used.

**3. Delete paragraph 5, IRC Regulations of SI Appendix 3 – Regatta Regulations and replace with:**

#### **APPENDIX 3 – REGATTA REGULATIONS**

##### **5 IRC REGULATIONS**

The maximum total number of crew shall not exceed the Crew Number printed on the boat's IRC certificate.

**4. IRC Rule 26.1.5 (d)** will not apply to IRC yachts on any day that a course in SI Appendix 4 – Around-the-Island Courses is designated. The Race Committee will announce their intention to run an Around-the-Island Race during their announcements at 0900 on VHF 72. This permits IRC yachts to change their sails for an Around-the-Island Race. Sails carried onboard on all other days shall remain the same on those days.
