- Carriage Tours of Acadia Park

  - 1 hour tour of Day Mountain \$ 18 per person, departs 9AM, 1PM
  - 2 hour tour of Rockefeller bridges \$25 per person, departs 10:30AM
  - 2 hour Jordan Pond House tea and popover \$20 per person, departs 1PM
