

How to Follow the 2018 Resolute Cup

"A Corinthian Championship for U.S. Yacht Clubs" September 10 to 15, Newport, R.I.

The Resolute Cup is more than just a regatta. It's a chance for yacht clubs from across the country to showcase their best amateur talent. With provided yachts and sails and standardized rigging, the regatta represents the most level playing field in the sport of sailing. Live multimedia coverage will enable fellow members, friends and family to follow the action as it unfolds on Narragansett Bay.

Race Schedule & Location

Racing is schedule to run Wednesday, September 12, through Saturday, September 15, starting each day at 1030. The 28 teams will rotate through a racing fleet of 21 boats, with each team sitting out one of every four races. We will run the rotation through Saturday morning when the top 14 teams will move to a double-point medal round of no more than three races. All racing will take place inside of Narragansett Bay. The primary race area is between Rose Island and Goat Island.

Race Tracking

2D tracking of every race will be available through the TracTrac app for <u>iPhones</u>, <u>iPads</u> and <u>Android</u> devices as well as through the Resolute Cup website and the <u>TracTrac website</u>. The 2D tracking will allow fans to follow a specific boat for the duration of the race. Replays are available following the conclusion of a race.

Live Coverage

The final two days of the 2018 Resolute Cup will be broadcast online. Live footage and 2D tracking animation will be accompanied by commentary from sailing experts Tucker Thompson and Andy Green. This coverage will be available via the Rolex New York Yacht Club Invitational Cup Facebook Page, where on-demand replays will be available.

The Rolex NYYC Invitational Cup Facebook page will serve as the event's media hub, with daily photo galleries of on-the-water action (by esteemed yachting photographer Paul Todd) and the onshore social activities, in-race updates, video highlights, post-race interviews and links to other key race information.
